






Worship Experience Which Mass at St Malachi's have you generally gone to over the last two years?

How important is it to maintain the different styles of the two Sunday Masses?





- Include the Parish Council minutes in the bulletin each month
- Promote St. Malachi experience in a unique way
- Bimonthly speakers, Adult Ed
- Include more parishioners in planning & organizing Sunday Morning activities
- Keep Mass under one hour
- Organize a young adult breakfast after Mass
- Create opportunities for unique community activities; ie spring plant sale, summer strawberry festival
- Have other prayer, education & PSR scheduled on weekday nights
- Forget the announcements because those given always can be read in the bulletin
- I appreciate a quiet, prayerful Mass with good music, a solid homily, & a well-trained reader
- Kids could be more involved in Mass if there was a kids/teens band/music group
- Mass should not last longer than 50 min; 15 min homilies
- I find it hard to stand during Mass and find it very hard to hold hands
- I suggest one side of the congregation kneel during the Eucharistic prayer and the other side stand
- Homilies not to exceed 7 min with a concise, clear message
- Love the choir & many meals after church
- Like to see more than 1 outdoor Mass per year
- Quarterly PSR presentations & seasonal activities can draw good attendance
- The focus of the Sunday Morning at St. Malachi program needs to be on what inspires & motivates people for good
- Need to understand how the Mass time has created many obstacles for many parishioners



- The younger members of the parish that are the future of the church should answer this question.
- I see there are folks moving in all over the area from W-79 to E-4th. How do we invite them with a
 welcoming packet or mailing and what are we inviting them to that is different than their local up the
 street parish? Can the ushers hand them a welcome packet not tell them to go to the office to get one
 as I being new would just leave and go home. Have to make it easy when they are new and checking us
 out. I notice at other churches they have a welcome packet at all their doors.
- Keep the Masses to one hour.
- Do announcements at beginning of Mass. Include any urgent /specific needs in back door parish ministry
- Too few people
- As a parent, I liked going to Mass WHILE my child attended PSR (before she made her 1st Communion).
- "We belong to 2 churches besides St. Malachi. Malachi is my Church!
- If we want people to participate in adult education/enrichment opportunities, I think we need to offer them after Mass. Our tradition of coffee hour after Mass is still very popular, and then people might well be enticed into an activity they wouldn't have come for at a time before Mass.
- Continue 9:00 Mass & return to11:00 Mass. During the summer months, have only 1 Mass at 10:30.
- PSR should be a shared experience with St. Pats, alternating every other year as the host parish.


Parish School of Religion (PSR)

Do you have children currently attending PSR?






Other Comments/Suggestions:



- Forget the announcements because those given always can be read in the bulletin
- I appreciate a quiet, prayerful Mass with good music, a solid homily, & a well-trained reader
- Kids could be more involved in Mass if there was a kids/teens band/music group
- Mass should not last longer than 50 min; 15 min homilies
- I find it hard to stand during Mass and find it very hard to hold hands
- I suggest one side of the congregation kneel during the Eucharistic prayer and the other side stand
- Homilies not to exceed 7 min with a concise, clear message
- Love the choir & many meals after church
- Like to see more than 1 outdoor Mass per year
- Quarterly PSR presentations & seasonal activities can draw good attendance
- The focus of the Sunday Morning at St. Malachi program needs to be on what inspires & motivates people for good
- Need to understand how the Mass time has created many obstacles for many parishioners

- An active recruitment campaign to reach new parishioners seems long overdue. Perhaps it could kick off with a "bring a friend" to a vibrant signature St. Malachi Mass and a "marketing" team could do outreach to apartments in the back in flats, downtown residents, young Lakewood families, etc. Involving the kids into music ministry would help to foster the next generation at St. Malachi. I think we need to ask the question...who is the future of St. Malachi??
- I have a great deal of respect for Fr. Tony who has served the two parish St. Malachi's and the one parish St. Malachi's with patience and prayerfulness. I think our suggestions and thoughts should be shared in that same spirit.
